'FOCUS ON PROVIDING UNADULTERATED MILK TO CITIZENS' Home Minister. Detailed plan for White Revolution 2.0 is ready

THE DETAILED plan for White Revolution 2.0 has been ready to bring the core milk producing farmers of the country under the purview of the cooperative structure of National Dairy Development Board (NDDB), Union Home and Cooperation Minister Amit Shah said on Tuesday, adding that the focus was on providing unadulterated milk to citizens.

Shah was in Anand to attend the Diamond Jubilee celebrations of NDDB as well as the birth anniversary of Tribhuvandas Patel, called the founder of the cooperative movement in India, who established the Kaira District Co-operative Milk Producers' Union Limited, known as 'Amul'. At the event, Shah also invoked the contribution of former Prime Minister Lal Bahadur Shastri in setting up NDDB to "replicate the success of Amul across the country".

"Saying that Patel remained an 'unsung hero' in the establishment of the cooperative 'that changed the lives of the milk farmers in India', Shah said, 'He was a person who neither got due credit nor any reward, but five crore milk farmers in the country are leading a sustainable and prosperous life due to his vision and leadership. It was Shastri who created NDDB, which has

ensured that "mothers do not feed milk adulterated with urea" to their children.

He said, "It was in 1964 that the *karmath* (hardworking) Prime Minister of India, Lal Bahadur Shastri, visited Amul and decided to replicate the model across the country. And thus, NDDB was formed. Neither Tribhuvandas nor Shastri knew that the seed would become such a huge tree, which is the most successful and professional cooperative..."

He said the Amul brand of the cooperative has the number one world ranking, which is a feat. "It is not easy for a cooperative to market products and face the stiff competition from corporates; but it is a matter of pride that India's cooperative brand, Amul, has the

number one spot in the world, leaving behind even the US in terms of milk production."

He further said, "Of the 8 crore milk farmers in India, 1.5 crore are directly associated with the cooperative. As part of White Revolution 2.0, we aim to bring the remaining six crore farmers under the cooperative structure, which is essential to providing pure milk to people."

Shah said the only reason NDDB had been able to provide unadulterated milk to consumers was that it had "no owner". Shah said, "When (earlier) mothers fed milk to their children, little did they know that they were feeding urea to them... The credibility of Amul is that it is not mixed with urea and has also enriched the

health of children... Milk of the NDDB is unadulterated because it does not have an owner who thinks of his vested interests."

Rajiv Ranjan Singh, the Union Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying and Panchayati Raj, who was present at the event, also emphasised on the issue of 'adulterated milk products'. Ranjan said, "If milk is not produced in the cooperative sector, it will be difficult to provide pure milk to people. Today, there is a lot of adulteration in milk, which is leading to health issues..."

Shah, meanwhile, laid the foundation stone for a new NDDB office building and launched the Gir Ghee from Mother Dairy among other projects.

Seva, Suraksha are core values of Home Guards and Civil Defence organisations: Shah

Central government is planning to overhaul charters of Home Guards and Civil Defence, said the Union Home Minister

'SEVA' AND 'SURAKSHA' are important aspects of our culture that form the core values of the Home Guards and Civil Defence organisations, said Union Home Minister Amit Shah while sharing that the central government has planned a massive overhaul of the charters for them. This will be the first change made to the charters of these organisations in over 50 years, Shah said.

He made these remarks on Tuesday while attending the two-day 14th All India Annual Conference of Home Guards and Civil Defence being held in Gandhinagar.

Shah started off by congratulating Gujarat cadre IPS officer and Director General Vivek Shrivastava for organising the first annual conference in 20 years and admitted to a 'mea culpa' for not being able to pay attention to the Home Guards and Civil Defence sectors during his tenure as Union Home Minister.

Talking about the core values of the two organisations, Shah said, "Seva" and "Suraksha" are im-

portant aspects of our culture that are embodied in Home Guards and Civil Defence... Today, while I am here, I want to make public my difference of opinion (math-bhed) with a judgment of the Supreme Court. Some years ago, it gave a judgment where there was an attempt to link the Home Guards and Civil Defence (organisations) to their earnings. While I agree that an increase in pay is necessary, but the not of these organisations is Seva (service). It is the feeling of coming forward and volunteering to serve the society.

"If we kill this feeling with a judgment, these organisations will become just another workplace. These organisations unite society and service. It is our duty to uphold these values. Seva and Suraksha can be together in these organisations," Shah said. On the overhaul of their charters, Shah said, "In the next four months, we will make changes to your charters to make them relevant to modern times. Initially, it was mainly the duties during wartime. But if there is no change in the charter in 50 years, it becomes obsolete. Requirements of the country have changed in 50 years. While war may not happen, we can help in disaster management and traffic. The planning (for this) is at a nascent stage," the Union minister said. "We want to involve Home Guards and Civil Defence in disaster aid, Swachh Bharat, Nasha Mukh Bharat, women protection, women empowerment, helping in nutrition, vaccination drives and TB programme among other initiatives. We also want their involvement in cyber awareness and environmental issues. You can also help in stopping the dropout rates in education," he added.

Shah urged the Union and state leadership of the Home Guards and Civil Defence to stay back for at least one more day to discuss the overhaul.

'School dropout rate reduced after Modi became CM'

Ahmedabad: The dropout rate among Class V students has reduced from 37% to 2% while the enrolment rate increased from 66% to 99.8% after Narendra Modi took over as the Chief Minister of Gujarat, stated Union Home Minister Amit Shah at a programme in Gandhinagar on Tuesday.

"You must not have been born at that time (2001). The dropout ratio in Gujarat was 37%. Among 67% students enrolled at that time, 37% would drop out before Class V. But with schemes like Bet Bachao Bet Padhao and school enrolment drives started by Narendra Modi, the education situation has improved to a level where 99.8% children are now enrolled. The dropout rate has reduced to only 2%," Shah said during the distribution of Gujarat government's Namoo Lakshmi and Namoo Saraswati Vidyam Scholarships among students.

Referring to the National Education Policy 2020, Shah said it has created a lot of opportunities for students as they can learn much or history along with science. "But science stream is associated with your employment and that is the reason these two schemes have been brought into effect," he added. **ENS**
